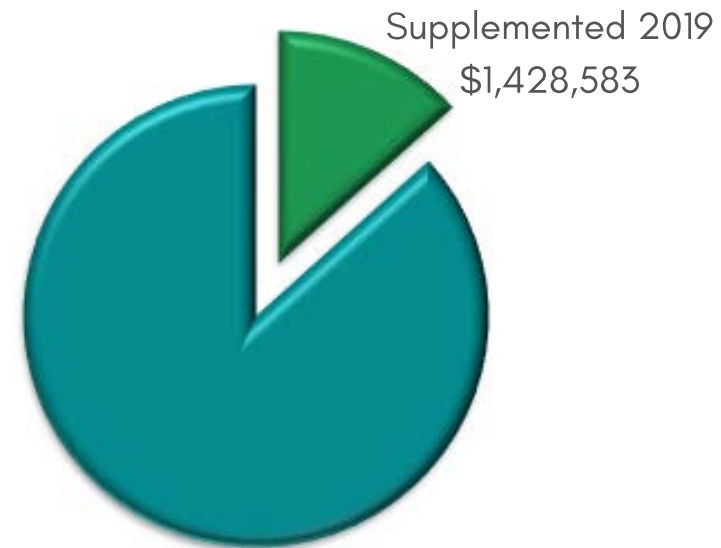

# ADOPT-A-FAMILY

The **Adopt-A-Family Program** subsidizes the cost of staying at the Family House to keep our room fee low. The program also covers costs for families who cannot afford the nightly fee, ensuring no family is ever turned away due to an inability to pay. In 2019, the Family House provided **9,401 nights** of care and supplemented **\$1,428,583** worth of services because of the support of our community.

Knowing families may be struggling, the Family House offers its accommodations and services for a highly subsidized fee of **\$40 per night**, despite the actual cost for the Family House to provide them totaling **more than \$185 per night**.

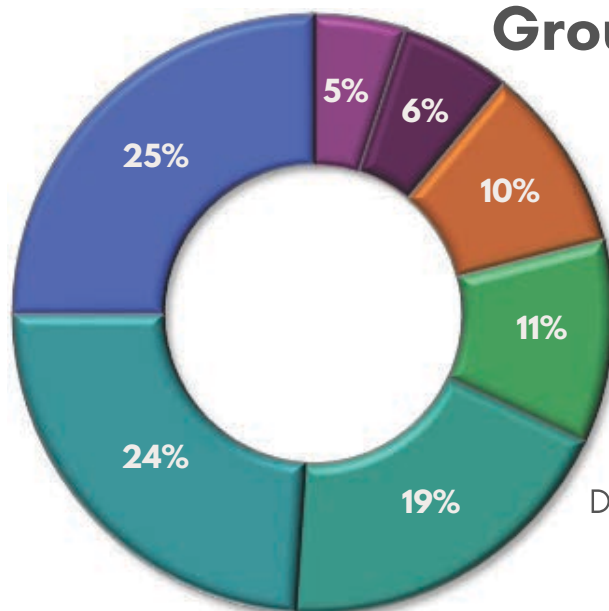

# HOME COOK HEROES

The **Home Cook Heroes Program** at Gift of Life Family House provides transplant patients and their families with a home-cooked meal prepared and served by volunteers and access to a full-service kitchen and a fully-stocked pantry. Guests and volunteers are encouraged to eat together in our dining room to share their experiences. Guests can also use our resources to prepare their own meals or grab a snack on their way to the hospital. In 2019, the Family House provided **33,680 meals** to transplant families.

## CAREGIVER LIFELINE

The **Caregiver Lifeline Program** provides families and caregivers with education and support as they navigate through the transplant process inside and outside the walls of the Family House. Resources are available to transplant caregivers whether they are current Family House guests, have returned home from the Family House, or have never stayed at the Family House. In addition to a full-time social work team on-site available for individual counseling, the program also offers an online informational library and caregiver support group, as well as community outreach programs to help families locate financial assistance, gain emotional support, and develop a support system.

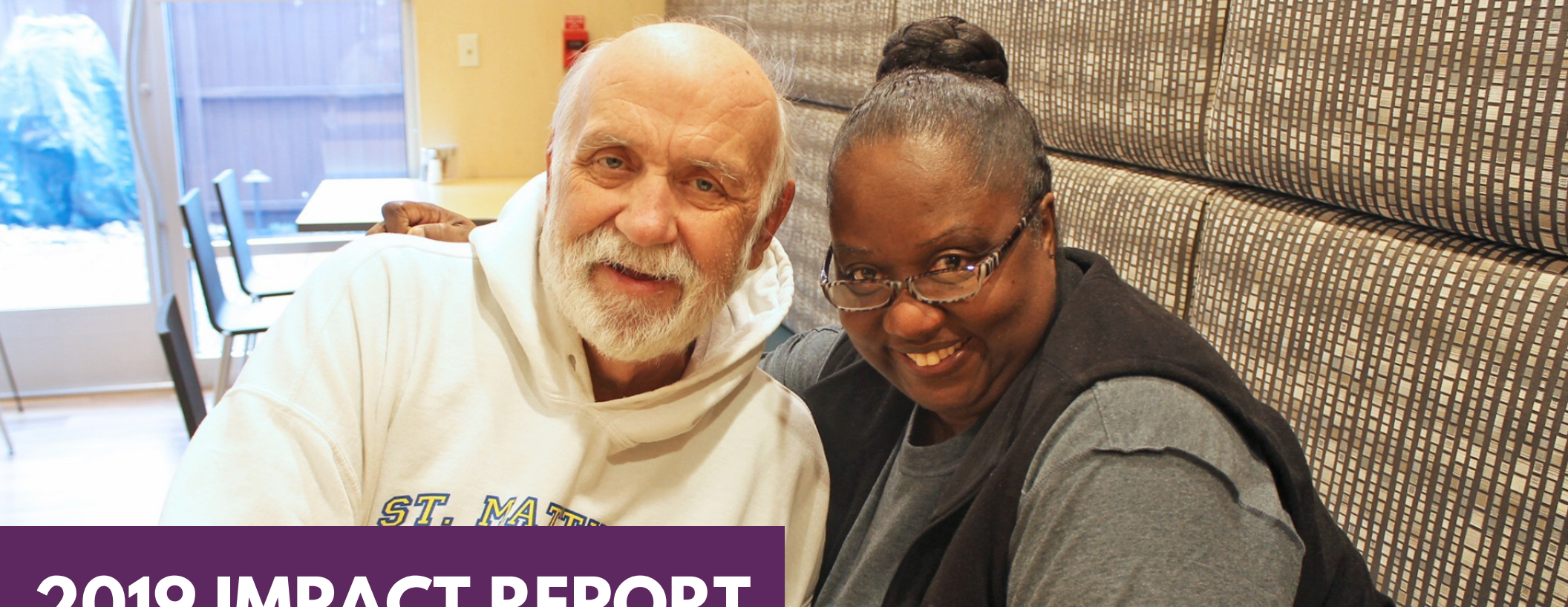

## Volunteer Program: Program Hours

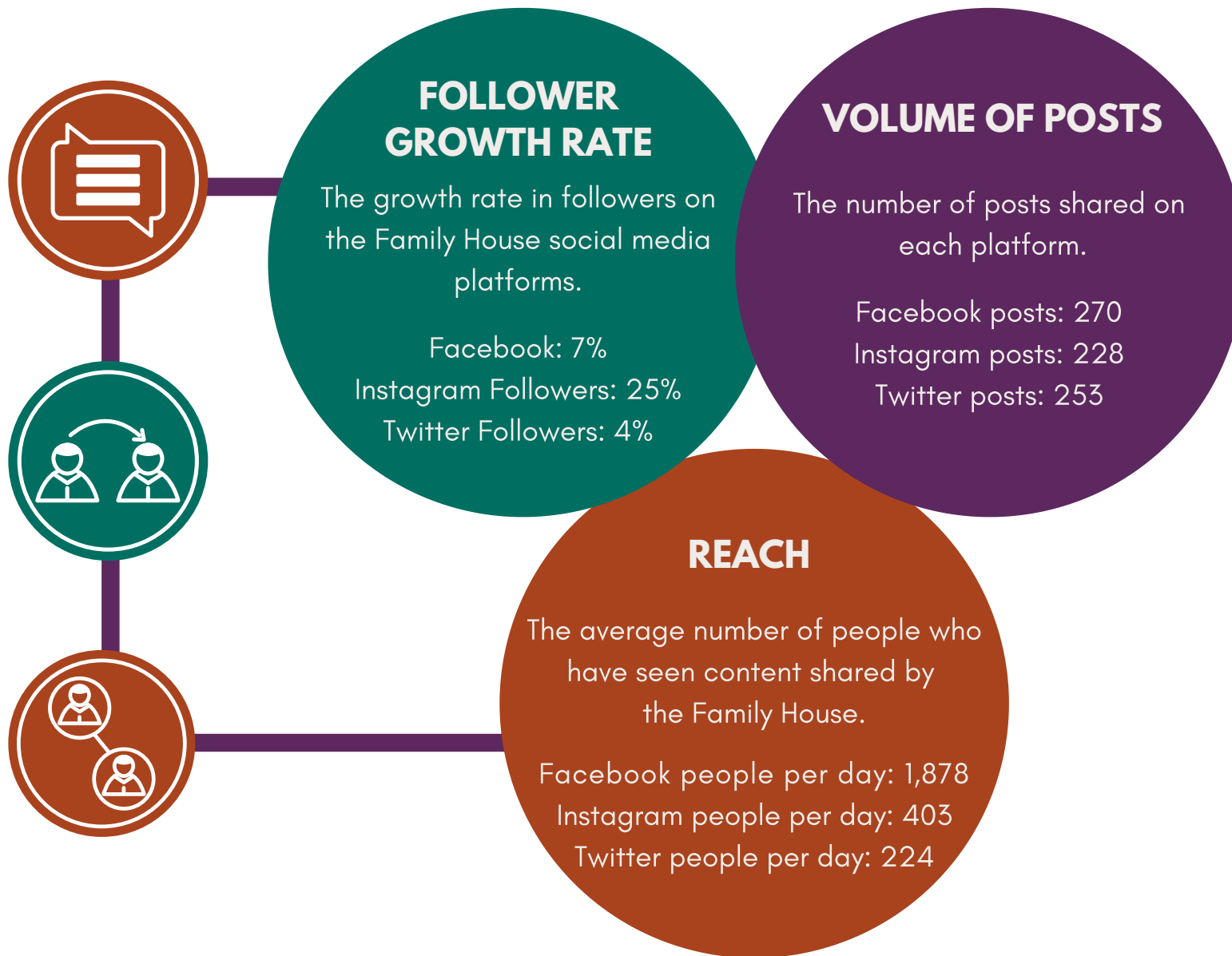


## Guest Activities Program: Number of Activities

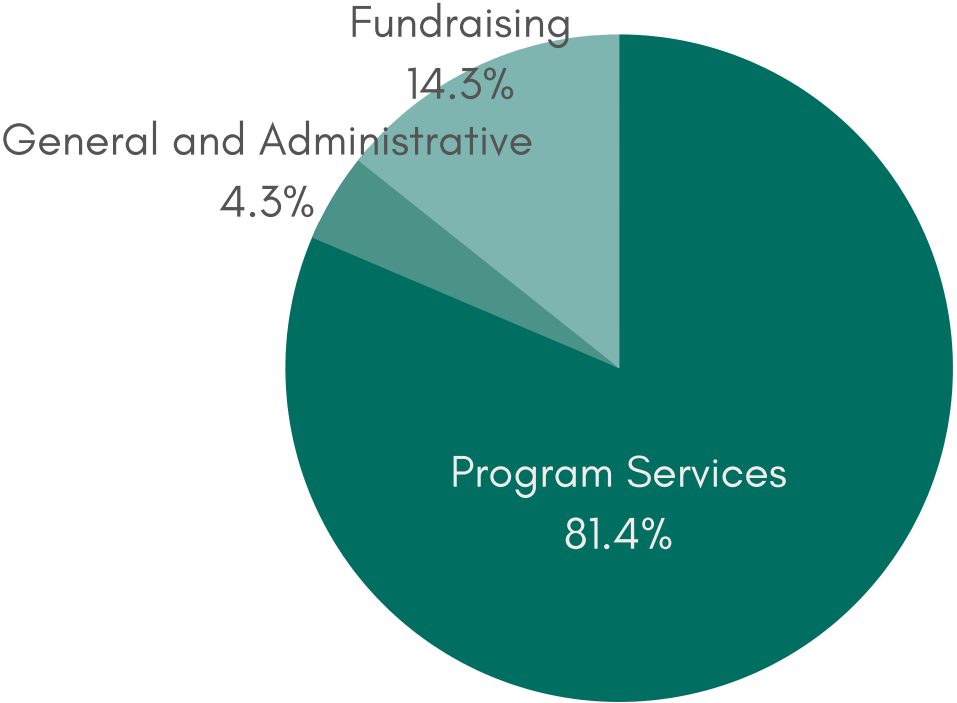

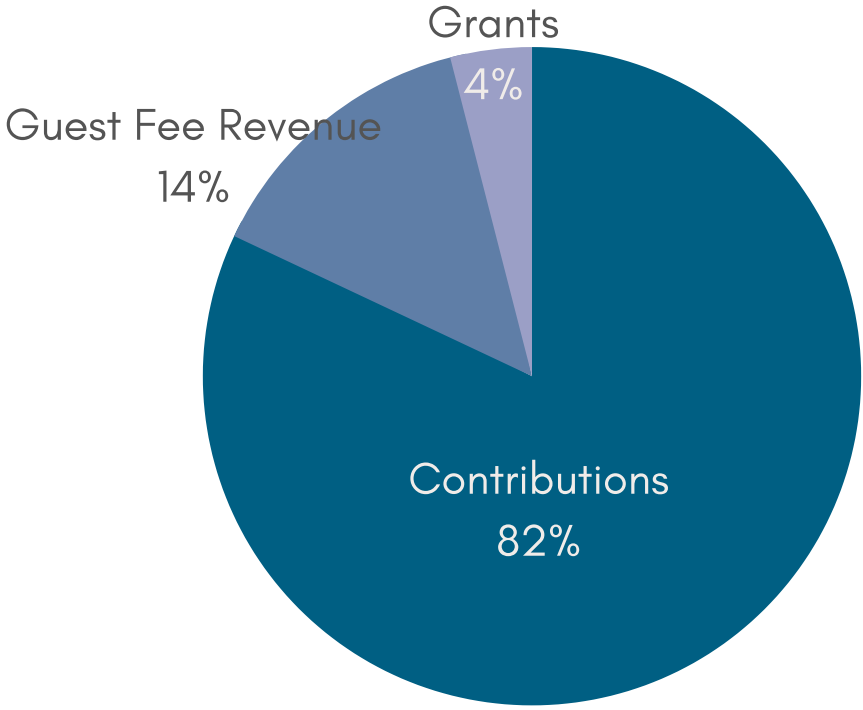
