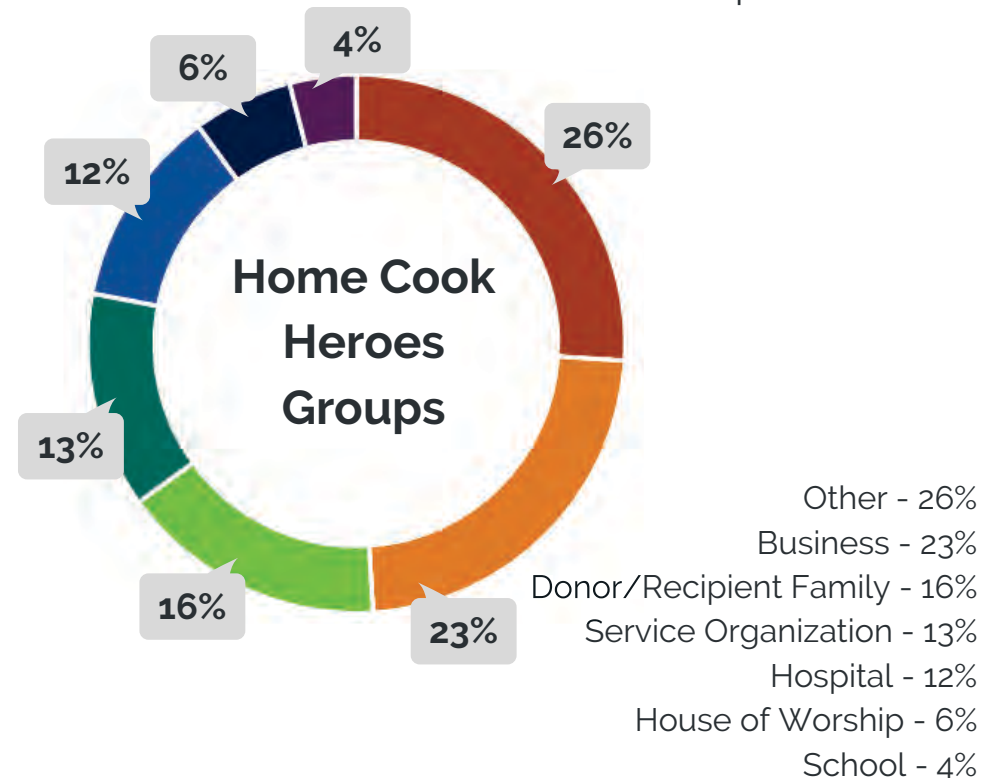

HOME COOK HEROES



The **HOME COOK HEROES PROGRAM** at Gift of Life Family House provides transplant patients and their families with a home-cooked meal prepared by volunteers and access to a full-service kitchen and a fully-stocked pantry. This year, our volunteers transitioned to dropping off prepared meals or arranging catering in lieu of coming in to cook for our guests. In 2020, the Family House provided **15,038 MEALS** to transplant families.



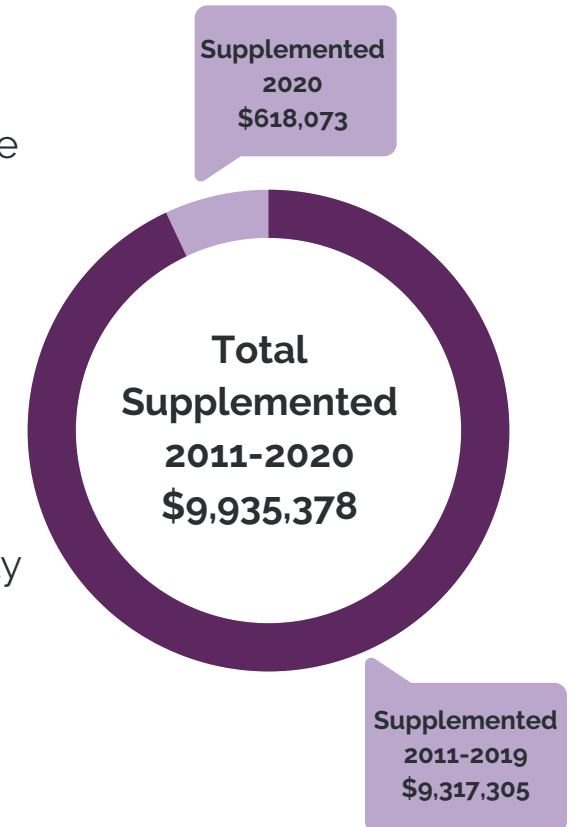

ADOPT-A-FAMILY PROGRAM



The **ADOPT-A-FAMILY PROGRAM** subsidizes the cost of staying at the Family House to keep our room fee low. The program also covers costs for families who cannot afford the nightly fee, ensuring no family is ever turned away due to an inability to pay. In 2020, the Family House provided **4,396 NIGHTS** of care and supplemented **\$618,073** worth of services because of the support of our community.

Knowing families may be struggling, the Family House offers its accommodations and services for a highly subsidized fee of \$40 per night, despite the actual cost for the Family House to provide them totaling more than \$175 per night.

The **CAREGIVER LIFELINE PROGRAM** provides families and caregivers with education and support as they navigate the transplant process. Resources are available to transplant caregivers whether they are current Family House guests, have returned home from the Family House, or have never stayed at the Family House. In addition to a full-time social work team available on-site for individual counseling, the program offers an online informational library and caregiver support groups, as well as community outreach programs to help families locate financial assistance, gain emotional support, and develop a support system.

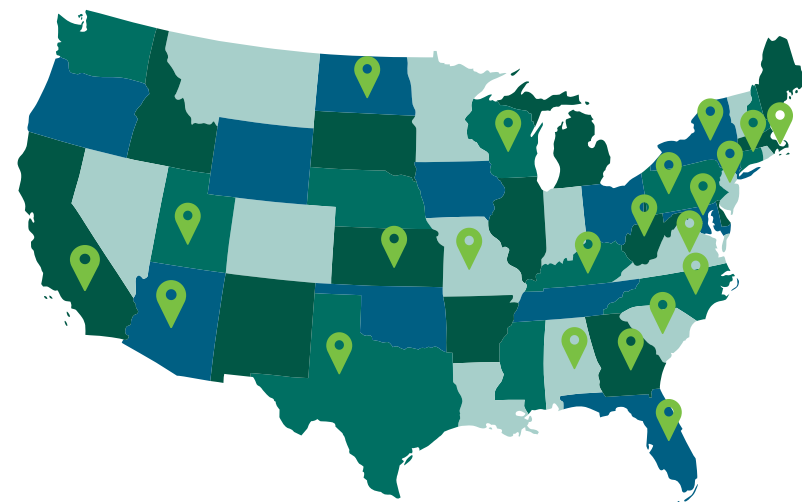

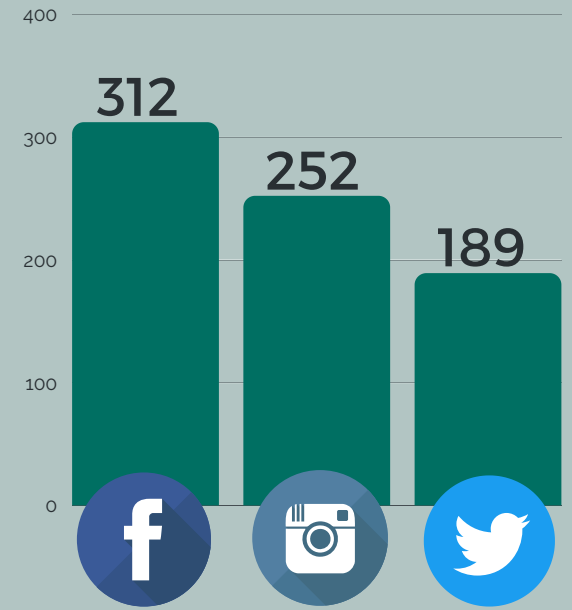
ENGAGEMENTS

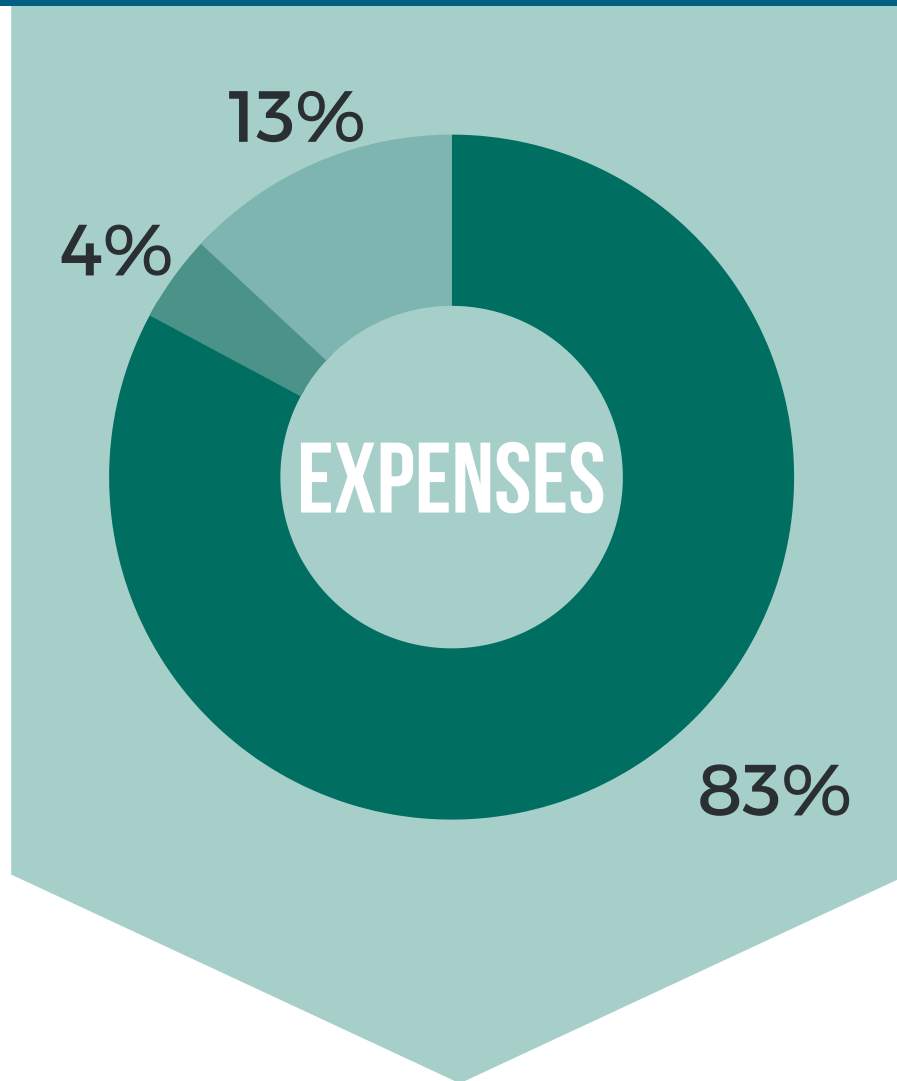

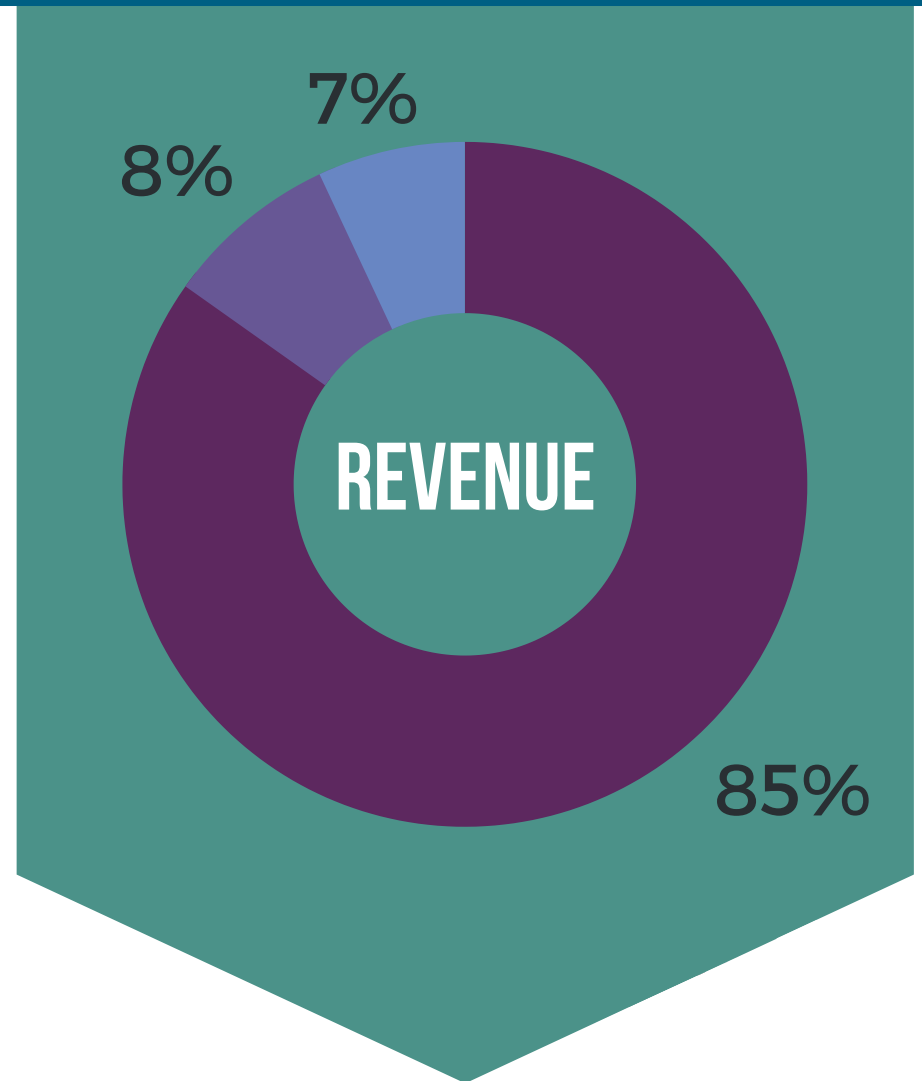
