CAREGIVER LIFELINE PROGRAM

The Caregiver Lifeline Program provides vital education and emotional support to patients and their caregivers through their transplant journey. In addition to having a full-time social work team on-site, the program offers a robust online resource library, peer support groups, live educational webinars, and continuing education opportunities for transplant and dialysis professionals.

TRANSPORTATION

The House supports guest transportation through our Shuttle Service, which provides rides to and from six local transplant centers throughout the Philadelphia area. When shuttle service is unavailable, the House subsidizes the cost of Uber and taxi rides to ensure guests can access the care they need. Twelve-year-old CJ waited more than three years for the heart transplant that would save his life. During that time, he spent months in the hospital, while his mom, Jessica, stayed nearby at Gift of Life Howie's House.

The House became a home away from home during this long, uncertain journey. It gave Jessica a safe, welcoming place close to the hospital, and provided CJ with comfort and community between his hospital stays and appointments.

"Staying at Gift of Life Howie's House was such a blessing," CJ says. "It was like our second home. I met so many other families at the House that helped us feel not so alone and the staff have been so nice and welcoming."

CJ received his heart transplant in January 2025. Now he's dreaming big - looking forward to swimming, playing sports, and one day becoming a heart surgeon.

Named in memory of Sean Dukes, a two-time heart transplant recipient and Gift of Life Advocate, the program includes STEM-focused activities that reflect Sean's passion and his career in aerospace engineering.
